Petition for Grant towards cost of new sound system in church: We will be asking for support after masses this weekend. Do please sign if you agree; the petition reads:

"I confirm that I support the proposal to install a new sound system in St. Mary's Parish Church, Glastonbury. The existing sound system, which is out-dated and has been in place for some decades, is inadequate and regularly malfunctions. There are several 'dead' areas in the church and sanctuary which are out of range and the poor quality of transmission in some areas makes it almost impossible to hear what's being said. This detracts from proper participation in the services taking place in the church. I support the installation of new, modern equipment, which will rectify these problems, and enable us to enjoy full participation in the services once more."
